CO2 CLIMATE MEASUREMENTS JUNE 2023 (Worsening)

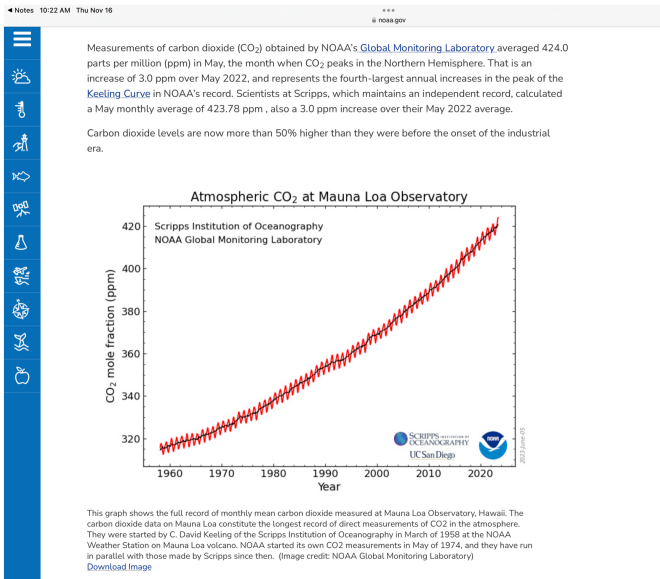

Because the global CO2 levels have already exceeded our 350 ppm safe level and reached 424 ppm: *Together, we're reverse this damaging trend.*

Here's some information about wildfires in California over the past decade:

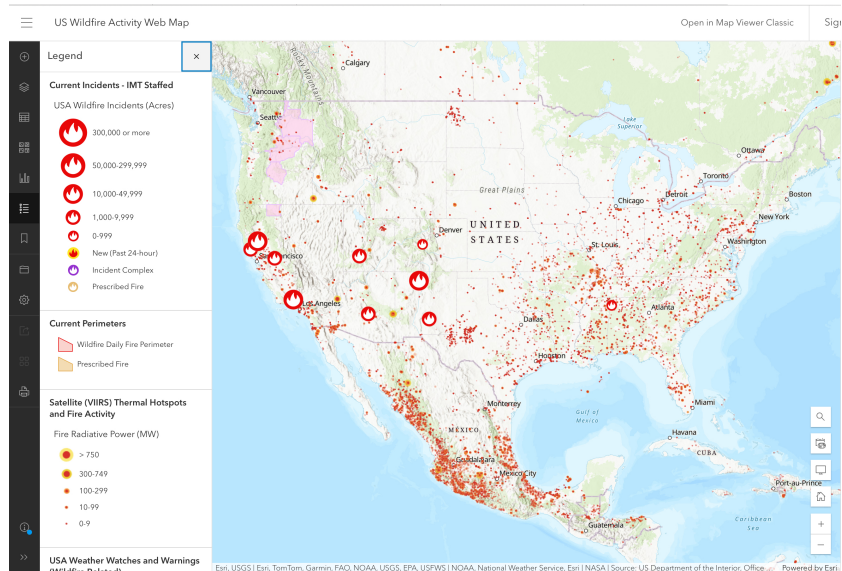
- 2002–2011: 10.1% of the USDA Forest Service's 12.7 million acres of forestland in California burned
- 2012–2021: 38.8% of the USDA Forest Service's forestland in California burned

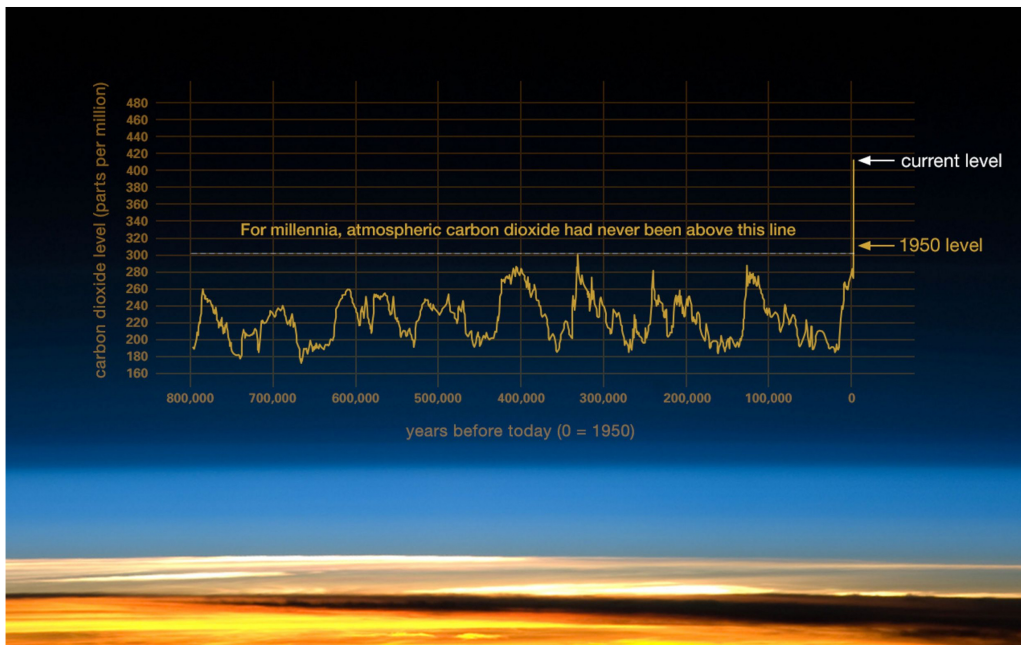
We blew past the recommended safe 350ppm of CO2. We're now over 424ppm and it's only increasing. 84 million more homes to convert. Because of our high CO2 levels, natural disasters are expected to be more frequent.

Installing battery + solar (ie: is like planting 92 square blocks of trees which absorb CO2) is best because it eliminates the CO2 used to fill 84 million home energy needs.)
